Fairbanks Community Center Campground Guidelines 2006

Primitive \$15.00/night      Electrical \$20.00/night      \$5.00/day parking per rig

Local checks or cash only.

1. Each camping group shall register and pay in advance for night(s) camping to a board member who will be around the campsites between 7p.m. and 9p.m. daily.
2. Campsites are on a first-come, first-serve basis.
3. One camping group shall be permitted to occupy one campsite in the family campground. No more than six (6) individuals may lawfully occupy one (1) campsite in the family campground (1 camper & 1 tent only).
4. Leasing or subleasing of campsites or equipment on a site is prohibited.
5. Quiet Hours are 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
6. 5 MPH Speed limit on campground roads at all times.
7. Animals must be kept on a leash/harness or caged at all times, and must be attended at all times. It is mandatory that you clean up after your animal. It is the responsibility of the owner of the pet/animal. Please bag then dispose of in dumpster.
8. All firearms and bows and arrows must be unloaded or un-nocked and stored in a case or locked in a vehicle when on LIFT property, except when participating in an activity authorized by LIFT, Inc.
9. No cutting of any trees at anytime or defacing property.
10. Campfires are allowed on campsites in fire ring only. Fires must be entirely extinguished after use.
11. No driving of nails into any trees or other property.
12. LIFT, Inc. is not responsible for any injuries, loss or damage.
13. Please, do not flush sanitary products (diapers, cloths, etc.) into the sewer system.
14. Parents are responsible for the safety and action of their children. Playing in or around washrooms or water taps prohibited. Parents must pay for any damage done by children.
15. No washing of clothes, dishes or utensils in restrooms. Dishwater must be disposed of through proper sanitary facilities and must not be discharged on the ground. Washing a vehicle or watercraft or animals in the camping area is prohibited.
16. Deposit all trash in dumpster at campground entrance.
17. Check-out time is 2 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 5 p.m. on Sundays and holidays. If you know you are going to be late getting back before checkout, please move your rig to the day parking area.
18. Showers will be available from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. in the uni-sex locker room in the basement. When a board member comes to check in and collect money, the gym doors will be locked. The only bathroom available will be the one in the gym. Campers are to bring their own toiletries & towels.
19. Rules are subject to change as LIFT, Inc. deems necessary.
20. If rules are not followed, you will be asked to leave the property and will not be allowed back on the property. LIFT reserves the right to refuse anyone.
21. Campers are camping at their own risk. Registration card must be kept in visible window on campsite. A signature on the rules is required each time camping.
