class will count for your first round score. You may choose any class to count, but you must indicate on your entry blank which one you want to count. No retroactive decisions on which to count will be accepted! The second round will be a posted Classic Hunter Course that will be scored by the judge. The Classic can be done at any time and fence height. The scores will be tallied for class placings. We must have 10 entries to award out the \$500. Less than 10 entries only ribbons will be awarded. The money awarded will be split 1st through 6th place; The split will be 30% for First place, 25% for second place, 20% for third place, 15% for fourth place, 5% for fifth and sixth place.

- 128 **\$500 Gambler's Choice: The fence height for Gambler's Choice will be 3'3" to 3'7" and the Joker will be 3'7" over. You must show in at least one complete jumper division (2 classes) prior to this class. Do as many jumps as you can within 60 seconds; jumps have different point values. You may only go over a jump once. Going over a jump more than once will call for elimination. The whistle will be blown after 60 seconds to let you know your time is up. You must start within 45 seconds of whistle being blown. Verticals: 25 points, Oxers: 50 points. Knockdown or refusal subtracts that fence's score value each occurrence from total score. You must go through the start and finish designated to be timed. Riders going clean and being within the time allowed of 60 seconds may attempt the IHC Joker fence valued score at 100 points; if there is a knockdown or refusal 100 points will be subtracted from your score. If a score is tied the awards will be placed by your time. We must have 10 entries to give out the \$500. If there is less than 10 entries only ribbons will be awarded. The money awarded will be split first through sixth place. The split will first place will get 30%, second place will get 25%, third place will get 20%, fourth place get 15%, and fifth and sixth place will get 5%**
