Type and Class Descriptions:

Types:

Baroque, Arabian, Gaited, Gypsy, Draft/Drum Horse

Baroque (Specific Classes #7 and #37) – “having the characteristics of a style of artistic expression prevalent especially in the 17th century that is marked generally by use of complex forms, bold ornamentation, and the juxtaposition of contrasting elements often conveying a sense of drama, movement, and tension.” Breeds include: Andalusian, Friesians, Lipizzaners, Lusitanos, Paso Finos, Peruvian Pasos, or some cross there of.

Arabian/Half Arabian (Specific Classes #8 and #35)

Gaited Breeds include: (Gaited-Only Classes include #9, #20, #23, #27, #30, #44)

Tennessee Walking Horse (Specific Class #24)

Mountain Horse (Specific Classes #39, #41)

Missouri Fox Trotter

Paso Fino

Gypsy (Specific Classes #10 and #36) – Gypsy Cob, Gypsy Vanner, or Gypsy Cross of any size or color.

Draft/Draft Cross/ Drum Horse (Specific Classes #11)- Draft breed or draft breed cross with heavier build and size. Drum horses are a cross between a draft and gypsy type.

Class Descriptions for Clarification:

Class #5. Grooming and Conditioning– Halter class in which horse’s coat condition and fitness level may negate conformation for placing in class.

Class #13. Suitability for Dressage In-Hand– Horse will be judge on movement in triangle pattern.

Class #14 and #15 Showmanship– Horses will perform a pattern in hand that may include trotting/gaiting, backing, turn on haunches, etc. Patterns will be posted day of show.

Class #21 Liberty– Horse will be let loose in arena for max of three minutes. At least 1.5 minutes must be movement at liberty, after the process of catching the horse may begin. Music should be preselected and go with movement of the horse. No tack other than halter if needed should be on horse during liberty, and only one handler in the arena. Music must be on CD or provided on phone or ipod player.

Class #22 Open Concours D’Elegance All Breed– Riders will dress in historical attire from 19th century or before.

Classes #30, #31, and #32 English Equitation– Horse and Rider will complete pattern as well as rail portion. Pattern up to judge.
